The Pan-African Scientific Research Council (PASRC) and the African School of Economics invite applications for the inaugural conference on the theme **“Rethinking Africa’s Way Forward: Growth through Investments in Education, Technology and Health”**.

The conference will convene innovative research around topics of **Education, Technology, and Health** across all disciplines including Natural Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences. Research should focus on Africa or be a comparative analysis involving at least one African country. The PASRC team will be looking for frontier research, rigorous methodology, generalizable findings, and comprehensiveness in the paper submissions.

In addition to parallel sessions focused on academic presentations of frontier work, the conference will include policy panels and keynote presentations from leading African scientists. There will also be career development sessions targeted towards early career scholars, covering topics like grant writing and applying for academic positions.
